Camping Information:

Camping will be from 12:00 pm Sunday, July 29th to 10:00 am Sunday, August 5th.

No campers, RV or motor homes will be allowed in the park before 12:00 pm on the 29th!

Camping fee for the full week will be \$40 (Berthusen Park or west field). When paying, you will receive one camping pass and one vehicle permit. If you wish to have a second vehicle the charge will be \$10. **All permits must be display in windows at all times while camping during the Threshing Bee.** You may camp in the park or in front of the care taker's house. There is a maximum of 1 vehicle per site in the field in front of the care taker's house and 2 vehicles per site in the park or west field. If you're camped by the care taker's house and you have a 2nd vehicle we ask you to park that vehicle by the 1st kitchen in the park. Camping is on a first-come, first-served basis. **There are no reservations or saving of spots.** We have never had to turn anyone away due to no vacancy. But this means that you park your rig & don't take up a lot of extra space so that we can accommodate everyone. When finding that perfect spot, there will be no moving of any logs, they're there for a reason. Please respect the boundaries and the natural vegetation.

When you come on Sunday, **after 12:00 p.m. on July 29th,** please find a place to park your camping vehicle. **The camp host will be posting host hours.**

No tractors/lawnmowers are allowed to be in the park for any reason. **Tractors & lawnmowers must stay in the show grounds area.**

The Camp Host or any officer of the club has the final say on issues that may arise throughout the week.

The Camp Host will take your money and give you a paid receipt to put in the window of your RV & vehicle so that it is visible when they do their daily checks. Please abide by the rules or you will be asked to leave.
